Food Items distribution Report UC Lar, Kot Jai & Bilot Tehsil Paharpur:

Pakistani nation is facing a new challenge in the shape of flood. Millions of people are affected due to flood and heavy rains. The loss of human lives, live stock, crops, land, buildings, communication network and electricity have occurred and disturbed the whole system, but where the problems occurred then there the solution produced. Not only in Pakistan but also from all over the world Pakistanis came forward and are paying their share to help the flood affected people.

Al noor Development Organization has been registered on 7th September 2004 under the voluntary social welfare agencies (ordinance 1961).

Its registration no is D.S.W/N.W.F.P/2377.Its working area is Tehsil Paharpur. AL noor is also a partner organization of Strengthening Participatory Organization (SPO) a national level NGO working for the rights of poor and disadvantaged communities.

Alnoor development organization (A.D.O) is also using their resources and standing side by side with the affected people of its respective area. In this situation there are three basic problems.

- 1. Shelter
- 2. Food
- 3. Medicines

For the purpose of shelter mostly people migrated/rescued to safe places. A.D.O helped the people to shifting them to suitable and safe places.

To fulfill their food requirements it was difficult task because the whole communication network including roads and phone network is almost disturbed. In this situation A.D.O assessed the need of people in the different union councils of tehsil Paharpur District Dera Ismail Khan.

After the assessment A.D.O realized that people in the open ground need the food at once because after the disaster of flash flood the intense need of food is being observed. In this regard A.D.O quickly responded and provided them prepared food for 10 to 15 days regularly.

A.D.O approached the different NGOs, line agencies & philanthropist fund generation to provide food and basic medicines for epidemic diseases broke soon after the flood. In this regard HUM(APPEC) gave very quick response to A.D.O. and immediately provided Rs.85000 for food items to be distributed among the worst affected families in the area. So with the mutual coordination among the A.D.O team and local stakeholders we prepared budget with share amount Rs.15240 and this leads to total amount of 100240 rupees. And it was decided to facilitate the 70 worst affected families by providing the 09 basic food items.

Process of Distribution:

After the assessment of the most vulnerable families affected by flood, the token was issued to the every House hold one day before the distribution. This distribution Token includes the Name of House Hold elder member, his/her CNIC number, complete address, Distribution point address.

After the verification by the distribution team (ADO) by already provided token and CNIC/its copy, food packages were provided to the all affected families.

For more transparency photographs of all the beneficiaries have been taken at the time of receiving.

There are three distribution points selected for facility of the people to avoid the hindrances, the distribution points were as follow:

- 1. Village Rang Pur Shumali, UC Lar Tehsil Pahar Pur (Distribution date 24-08-2010)
- 2. Village Khano Khel, UC Kot Jai
- (Distribution date 24-08-2010)

3. Village Dhakki, UC Bilot

(Distribution date 25-08-2010)

The packaging bags for the food items were provided by the community and transportation of the packages was delivered freely by a volunteer named Ghulam Shabbir. We also acknowledge the support of local legal advocate named Irshad Illahi Baloch for his precious efforts to make this distribution successful and transparent and also legally verified the document related to distribution.
